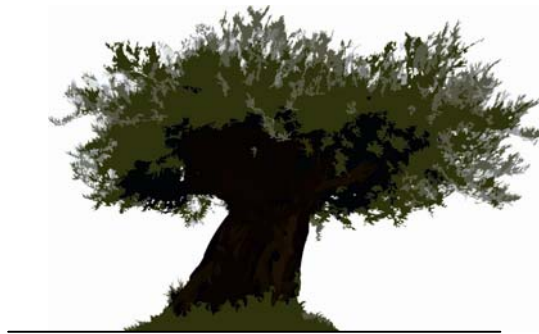


FRENCH PRESIDENTIAL ELECTIONS 2017

My programme would consist of 22 questions and proposals in 7 fields.

22 questions

Are we capable of managing ourselves?

Can we change the system without changing mankind?

Can we give perfect laws to imperfect people?

Should we keep the nation as a model or merge into a European empire and how do we go from globalisation to universalisation?

Should we merge the two houses of parliament, create a single one through a random draw and should we carry on with representative democracy?

Should we retain a single Head of State or replace it with a collegial system of government at the highest level?

If France's head is in Paris but not its heart, should we bring the two closer together?

Given that all societies and communities are based on initiation rites, what rites should we foster and put in place?

Who from finance or greed should be fought?

Do we need to rebuild the international monetary system? Is a world in which money is not hoarded possible? Would a return to a standard be judicious or desirable?

Would introducing a "temporal" tax (giving time to society) into the fiscal system be a good and workable idea?

If I have two children of working age and only work for one, what do I do?

Who of the debtors or creditors will pay our debts? Is a world without debt possible?



Should we foster competitiveness or cooperation?

Can forgiveness replace revenge?

Are we the owners or managers of this Earth? If we are merely the managers, why would we hand it back less liveable in than when it was lent to us?

How can we affirm male/female equality - that they are equal as incarnate spirits - while still respecting the differences between sexes?

Should we reveal the truth about extraterrestrials and our contact with them? Are we ready and able to listen to them and understand them? Are we up to the passage of July 2019?

If we are incarnate spirits, should we consider other "extraterrestrial" bodies as brother/sister incarnate spirits?

Why should we not do unto others as we would not have others do unto us?

If our bodies are but vehicles, should we change them for ones more suited to our entry into a new era?

How can we progress spiritually? Can love help us?



Proposals in 7 fields.

These proposals are to be read in the conditional as my aim is not to impose but to suggest. (There are 49 other proposals in my 2012 programme at olivier2012.org)

The monetary system, macro economy:

The rebuilding of the international monetary system with a reduction in the role of money as the sole means of payment.

A reduction in the market's role in setting prices.

A revaluation of work and a rethinking of the work/pay link and the minimum wage.

Global cooperation with rights and duties:

Work should fulfil the basic needs (food, healthcare and accommodation) of everyone in the world, particularly through the revaluation of agriculture (using methods that respect our Mother Earth) and the promotion of preventative medicine because everyone should have a roof over their heads, food on the table and healthcare but they should have to give something (to be defined) back because each right comes with a duty.

Socialisation and rites of initiation:

Sharing out or mutualising some less pleasant chores as an initiation right and temporal tax.

An obligatory period "in the other person's shoes" for all those taking up management or judging roles or who harm another.

Exopolitics:

Formalising, in an orderly manner, our contacts with other, extraterrestrial, intelligent beings at a UN level; we could envisage co-operation with well-meaning beings if they so wish and if we deserve it.

A general amnesty and pardon for leaders who said nothing or lied.



Environment, climate change and nuclear fission and fusion:

Massive investment in research into the new technologies and energies of tomorrow (in particular in fusion, as a number of spirits advise). All nuclear installations around the world should immediately come under UN control, with countries giving up national ownership of their installations (although they would still own the ground), with management and maintenance being undertaken by a world body.

A radical reduction in greenhouse gasses and land and sea pollutants.

Governance and presidency:

Great thought should be given to the increase in direct democracy at a legislative level and voting. Thought should also be given to governance by male-female pairs, representing the complementarity and equality of Dorism and Ionism, of Yin and Yang.

The president's salary, (if there is still a sole president) could be the average French wage. Those with power could undergo an annual health check so that their capabilities could be judged.

A new anthem should be created with new state symbols representing new energies.

Education:

Phases of education could be expanded, setting aside periods throughout your life and in all places from universities to prisons.

A study should be made into spiritual and energetic education.

Artistic creativity should be boosted.

New media outlets dedicated to harmony, love and spiritual elevation should be created.
